

Drywipe Dancer

You will need:

- A glass bowl or ceramic plate
- A drywipe marker
- A jug of water

What to do:

Simply draw a stick person on the bottom of the bowl, then angle the bowl towards you and pour water into it. Gently tilt the bowl so it becomes flat and the water moves underneath the pen marks. Your picture will lift off the glass surface and wiggle around as if it has come to life! It doesn't always work first time, but keep trying!



Why does this happen?

The ink of drywipe pens are made from a mixture of alcohol and coloured pigment. When you pour water onto the ink, the alcohol dissolves, leaving the coloured pigment floating on top of the water!
